

Which cookies do we use?

At Eteck we use three types of cookies: functional, analytical and third party cookies. Below we provide a clear overview of which cookies we use.

Functionality cookies

These cookies ensure that the website functions properly. You cannot disable these cookies.

Cookie id	Duration	Provider	Description
cookiebar_policy	1 year	Eteck	This cookie is used to remember your choices regarding the acceptance or rejection of cookies.
csrftoken	1 year	Eteck	This cookie is associated with Django web development platform for python. Used to help protect the website against Cross-Site Request Forgery attacks
rc::a	Never Expires	Google	This cookie is set by the Google recaptcha service to identify bots to protect the website against malicious spam attacks.
rc::c	session	Google	This cookie is set by the Google recaptcha service to identify bots to protect the website against malicious spam attacks.
sessionid	session	Eteck	Is used to save sessions and is essential for the correct functioning of the website
stickypage	1 year	Eteck	This cookie is set for on page functionality that sets redirect functionality on sub content pages

Analytics cookies

These cookies allow us to measure website usage and make improvements.

Cookie id	Duration	Provider	Description
_ga	1 year 1 month 4 days	Google Analytics	Google Analytics sets this cookie to calculate visitor, session and campaign data and track site usage for the site's analytics report. The cookie stores information anonymously and assigns a randomly generated number to recognise unique visitors.
_gid	1 day	Google Analytics	Google Analytics sets this cookie to store information on how visitors use a website while also creating an analytics report of the website's performance. Some of the collected data includes the number of visitors, their source, and the pages they visit anonymously.
ga*	1 year 1 month 4 days	Google Analytics	Google Analytics sets this cookie to store and count page views.
_gat_UA-*	1 minute	Google Analytics	Google Analytics sets this cookie for user behaviour tracking.
hjSessionUser*	1 year	Hotjar	Hotjar sets this cookie to ensure data from subsequent visits to the same site is attributed to the same user ID, which persists in the Hotjar User ID, which is unique to that site.
hjSession*	1 hour	Hotjar	Hotjar sets this cookie to ensure data from subsequent visits to the same site is attributed to the same user ID, which persists in the Hotjar User ID, which is unique to that site.

Third party cookies

These cookies may be set by third parties, such as YouTube or Vimeo.

Cookie id	Duration	Provider	Description
ytidb::LAST_RESULT_ENTRY_KEY	Never Expires	YouTube	This cookie is used by YouTube to store the last search result entry that was clicked by the user. This information is used to improve the user experience by providing more relevant search results in the future.
YSC	session	YouTube	Youtube sets this cookie to track the views of embedded videos on Youtube pages.
VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE	6 months	YouTube	YouTube sets this cookie to measure bandwidth, determining whether the user gets the new or old player interface.
VISITOR_PRIVACY_METADATA	6 months	YouTube	YouTube sets this cookie to store the user's cookie consent state for the current domain.
__Secure-ROLLOUT_TOKEN	6 months	YouTube	Registers a unique ID to keep statistics of what videos from YouTube the user has seen.
